The goal and objective for this document is to define the future strategy for InData.









The strategy is based upon and developed from the current InData Decalogue 2022.

Mission

InData's mission is to proactively support the harmonized digitalization of EPD and generic data for construction products according to EN 15804 in order to assess and improve the environmental performance of buildings and infrastructure. Data quality principles shall ensure that machine-readable EPD and generic data follow the same data format rules and are communicated in a transparent, credible, and user-friendly way throughout the value chain.

Strategy priorities

-  International harmonization of the data format for digitalization of EPD and generic data
-  Maintenance and evolution of the ILCD+EPD format under consideration of other digital formats (e.g. ISO 22057) and needs of the market
-  Stakeholder engagement platform for cooperation and collaboration with relevant stakeholders
-  Establish liaison with ECO-Platform, and other relevant institutions using ILCD+EPD format, in regard of acceptance of InData maintaining and developing the data format
-  Development and dissemination of guidance papers on data format including harmonisation and data quality aspects
-  Communication of data format and corresponding information on InData webpage
-  Education and promotion of the implementation of the data format in relevant events, exhibitions, and forums
-  Support by members who accept the Decalogue, and rules and contribute to the implementation of the objectives.
